

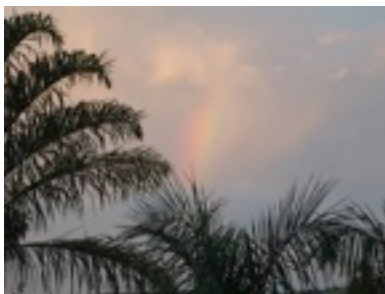
Long Journey to Africa
